**Appoint Volunteer Treasurer:** (Action) Ms. Tindall moved the appointment of Ms. Debra Birkby as volunteer Treasurer for the district which was seconded by Mr. Anderson. All in favor. Motion carried.

### **New Business:**

**Vice President Position:** (Action) Mr. Anderson moved that Ms. Darr Tindall be made Vice President of the district which was seconded by Mr. Campbell. All in favor. Motion carried.

SCADA System Upgrade Work: (Action) Three bids were reported for the necessary SCADA system upgrades at the plant; Industrial Systems for \$21K, Portland Engineering for \$25.9K and the Automation Group at \$25.3K. This system software was reported by Mr. Chick to be the brains of the plant giving the conditions of the pumps, flow rates, tank levels and other essential information. The SCADA System, Alarm software, and computer will all be upgraded to Windows 10.

Ms. Tindall moved execution of a contract with Industrial Systems for the proposed SCADA upgrade work which was seconded by Mr. Campbell. All in favor. Motion carried

## Manager Report July 19, 2019

## **SANITARY**

We received 1.5" of rain in June. The plant treated 2.1 MG of influent

The Webb Generator has now been fixed after its breakdown incident in May. Repairs have included a new fuel priming pump, fuel injector pump, and control board. This required several visits from a technician from CAT.

All Lift Stations had the wet wells cleaned by a Vactor truck this week, removing grease and sediment.

I have sent Kubota the signed contract for the purchase of the new membranes for the wastewater plant, and am waiting on details for shipment from Japan. We would ideally like to do this work this fall.

Spartan Environmental was here on 7/15 to do some camera inspection work of lateral lines, and to do some manhole work.
